

TRA 2023 Results

- 62 TRAs completed
- 11 different clinics referred clients for TRA
- 31 providers referred clients for TRA
- Caregiver/Adolescent traveled from 29 different cities
- Clients age range 14yrs-19yrs
- 65% utilized Medicaid Managed Care for coverage
- PEDICAT responsibility scores improved in 100% (test/retest),
- results vary Transition Readiness Assessment Questionnaire (TRAQ)
- Increased gains noted in TRA assessment vs generalized OT assessment
- Generalized OT providers reports TRA limitation
- Parents report high satisfaction with TRA experience

PEDICAT Standardized Assessments TRA vs Generalized

Transitional Readiness Focused Occupational Therapy Data 7 of 39 were completed Twice

- ADL Scaled Score improvements documented 71%
- Responsibility Scaled Score improvement documented 100%

Generalized Occupational Therapy Data

- 8 of 39 were completed Twice
- ADL Scaled Score Improvements documented 50%
- Responsibility Scaled Score improvements documented 63%
